### Admissions

The number of places available for admission to the Reception class each year will be a maximum of 30. This arrangement follows consultation between the Governing Body, the Diocesan Board of Education, the Local Education Authority and other admissions authorities in the area. The Governors will not place any restrictions on admissions to the Reception class unless they are advised that the number of children for whom admission is sought is likely to exceed this number.

**N.B.** For parents interested in their children gaining admission to St Christopher's High School at the end of Year 6, please note that family church attendance forms part of their admissions policy.

### Induction Programme

All children offered a place are admitted into school at the beginning of the Autumn Term. In the term prior to admission, parents are invited into school for an Open Evening and the children are invited to spend 3 half day sessions in school during the Summer Term.

### School Organisation

St Mary Magdalen's is a Primary School that provides full time education to boys and girls between the ages of 4 and 11 years. It is a Voluntary Aided Church School, adjacent to the parish church and housed in a Victorian building.

There are 7 classes and 196 children on roll.

The children move through the school according to their chronological age.
