School Premium Funding 2017/2018

The government is providing additional funding to improve the provision of PE and Sport in primary schools. For the 2017/2018 academic year our school received £14,065 based on our number of pupils.

We will use this funding to continue our commitment to raising standards in Physical Education, to raising fitness and well-being of our pupils and to raising the profile of Physical Education throughout school.

School has already purchased a range of Physical Education equipment to improve standards in Physical Education. Such as a range of balls, bats, bibs etc. New mats for the hall have also been purchased and new netball posts will soon be ordered. The cost of these resources is £2000.

From April 2017-July 2017 the school also had One Goal running dance sessions and multiskill sessions one day per week for KS2 pupils. After school and lunch time fitness sessions also took place. The cost of this was £2300

The school also has a coach to run multi-skills sessions for KS1 classes, one day per week and breakfast and after school fitness sessions daily. The cost of this is £4,600.

From September 2017 Mrs Brown (PE leader) supports staff in school with the teaching and planning of PE and fitness sessions one afternoon per week. The cost of this is £3000 for the year.

Judo sessions, Accrington Stanley, Fencing and Dance clubs have also been arranged to promote PE and to raise fitness levels. £1500 has been budgeted to cover the cost of these clubs.

Staff have also attended various PE courses to help raise standards of PE throughout the school, £600 has been budgeted for staff courses.
